<u>Discharges from Waikato Hospital</u> – lengthy conversation on concerns, impact on drivers and the need to share the information with WDHB.

Sarah has arranged for a meeting with Dallas Honey on April 10<sup>th</sup> to determine how best to find and share the thoughts from the Community Transport sector.

- One off stories weren't enough. We need to gather stories as a collective to get bigger impact for change.
- How to market the feedback? Survey, memo, video, report
- Discussion around difficult circumstances, whether shuttle operator can push back and say no
- Resthome discussion/examples
- Discussion on how transit lounge works- we weren't entirely sure. Need to highlight this issue to DHB
  - Develop flow diagram
- Discussion around need to look after volunteers
  - Different ones have different levels of problems
- Some Doctors are looking to use shuttles to get patients to hospital
- What happens when shuttles say no?
  - o (eg) if there are circumstances when people have no support
- Where is the line between being a transport service and a social service?
- Question was asked if the operator were 'tied into' the towns social services? Shuttle operator consensus seemed to be that they would not have previously been taken on a role to connect patients to social services
- Some shuttle operators send monthly reports to DHB with info on patients
- Question was asked what shuttle operators want DHB to change.
  - Better info sharing?
  - More timely discharge
- Does the DHB create a role to focus on gathering the information they need and provide to service through one point of contact? The DHB needs to value the work of volunteers
- DHB hold list of community health transport providers- where did they get this info from?
- DHB consumer panel raise transport issues with this panel
- Issue around early appointments- potential to put notice in vans/shuttles
- Diane Burgess agreed to attend meeting with Dallas. Bridget Burdett will also be there.
